If a school does not have a home match before the third Friday, then it must make arrangements for a visiting wrestling coach to weigh the squad. Any wrestler who fails to weigh in during the Certified Weighing Period must weigh in on *three consecutive weeks* at the Certified Weight.

### Notice to Football Officials

Football officials who failed to return the Number I National Federation open book examination by October 1, were mailed the Number II examination. Those receiving the Number II test must return the answer sheet to Association headquarters by December 15, or they will not be permitted to register for football officiating next year.

### Wichita East and Johnson State Cross Country Champions

Two new champions emerged from the State Cross Country Meet held at the Airport Golf Course in Emporia on November 3. Wichita East edged Wyandotte for the State Class A title, and Johnson won the Class B division, with LeRoy placing second.

Tom Yergovich of Wyandotte won the Class A individual division title with a record time of 9:28. Charles Harper of Wichita North ran a close second, with Mike Tarry of Mulvane the third-place winner.

Bruce Crotts of LeRoy, a first-time winner, walked off with the Class B individual championship. Bill Baxter of Fontana was the runner-up, and Steve Meredith of Viola placed third.
