

Wichita East, Concordia, Caldwell and Pretty Prairie 1962 State Track Champions

Coach Bob Timmons' Wichita East Blue Aces captured their second consecutive track and field title, and their 16th in the past 25 years, in the Class AA division of the State Track and Field Meet held at Kansas State University, Manhattan, on May 18 and 19. Paced by sprint star Bob Hanson, East rolled up 35 points. Wyandotte took home the second-place trophy with 28 1/10 and Topeka came in a close third with 26 2/5 points.

Concordia and Caldwell battled to a tie for the Class A championship with 16 points each. Fine individual performances by Steve Meats of Concordia and Caldwell's Ken Ryand paced the co-champions. Second-place honors went to Hill City with 13 points. Herington and Wakeeney finished on the heels of the runner-up with 12 points each.

Pretty Prairie won its third Class B state track and field championship by edging second-place Palco 16 1/2 to 15. Blue Mound came in a close third with 13 points. The champions were paced by high jump winner Mike Stucky.

Tennis Titles Go to Topeka, Winfield, Lindsborg and Buhler

Topeka High School senior John Grantham became the first tennis player to win three state Class AA singles titles. Grantham was pushed the limit in his first round against Winfield's Darrell Snyder and then breezed through the semifinals and finals for the singles championship at Manhattan on May 18. The Winfield Vikings dominated the Class AA doubles division by taking home the championship and runner-up trophies. Hal McCoy and Mike Kraus defeated teammates Dale Hendrickson and John Kretzer in the finals.

Marlin Nelson of Lindsborg was pushed to three sets in the finals before he defeated Jim Buller of Buhler for the Class A singles crown. Buhler's doubles team of Max Harder and Gary Schmidt recovered from a first set defeat in the finals to sidetrack Mick Weiberg and Grant Sechler of Anthony.

Wyandotte and Healy Win State Baseball Championships

Wyandotte of Kansas City captured the Class AA-A championship at El Dorado and Healy walked off with

the Class B title at McPherson in the state baseball tournaments held May 17-19. This was the first state baseball crown for Healy and the second for the Wyandotte Bulldogs.

In the championship game at El Dorado, Wyandotte jumped off to an early lead and went on to defeat cross-town rival, Ward, 5-1. The Bulldogs had disposed of Newton 2-0 the first round and Wichita West 10-1 in the semifinals. Ward earned the right to play for the title by beating Wichita Southeast 7-6 in the first game and shutting out Victoria 9-0 in the second round.

At McPherson, Healy blanked Lucas 7-0 in the opening round of play and then won with another shut-out over Rose Hill 5-0 in the semifinals. In the championship contest Healy scored two runs in the second inning and eight in the seventh to sidetrack Collyer 10-3 and earn the right to take home the first place trophy. Collyer defeated Wetmore 5-3 on Thursday and knocked off Hartford 6-3 in the second round.

All teams qualified for the state tournaments through regional play. Class AA-A regionals were held at El Dorado, Ward (Kansas City), Wichita East and Great Bend. Uniontown, Rossville, Udall, Windthorst (Spearville), Lenora and Lucas were hosts to the Class B regionals. Winners of the first and second places in the AA-A division qualified for the State Tournament and only first-place winners qualified in Class B. Culver and Westphalia, second-place regional teams, were invited to the Class B State Tournament to complete an eight-team bracket.
