

ASHLAND, WICHITA EAST WIN STATE TRACK TITLES

Two New Class A Records Established In Pole Vault and Discus; Dighton and Hutchinson Share Runner-Up Honors

New champions were crowned in both classes of the state track meet at Wichita May 14 and 15 when Ashland replaced Blue Rapids at the top of Class B and Wichita East succeeded Hutchinson as the Class A champion. Two new Class A records in the pole vault and discus and a tie of the Class A high hurdle mark featured the meet.

First of the records to tumble was the Class A pole vault mark of 12 ft. 4 $\frac{3}{8}$ in. set by Benson of Hutchinson in 1939. Don Price, Highland Park high school, Topeka, skimmed over the bar at 12 ft. 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ in. during Friday's competition in the A division to establish the new mark. The Class A discus record of 146 ft. 11 $\frac{1}{8}$ in. set by Grim, Wellington, in 1942, lasted only a year until it was bettered at Wichita by Rollin Prather, Eureka, with a toss of 155 ft. 2 $\frac{3}{8}$ in. Despite a strong head wind for Saturday's finals, Rowe of Fredonia tied the high hurdle mark of 14.9 set by Porter, Winfield, in 1937.

In winning the Class B championship Ashland was spearheaded by Bill Grimes, star sprinter, who won the 220 and 440 dashes and finished second in the 100, to score 14 points. Ashland also tied for first in the mile relay for a team total of 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ points. Second place went to Dighton with 17, while Pretty Prairie was third with 16.

Wichita East captured only one first place, but scored heavily in other places and amassed 27 $\frac{1}{2}$ points to almost double Hutchinson's second place score of 15. Eureka was third with 13.

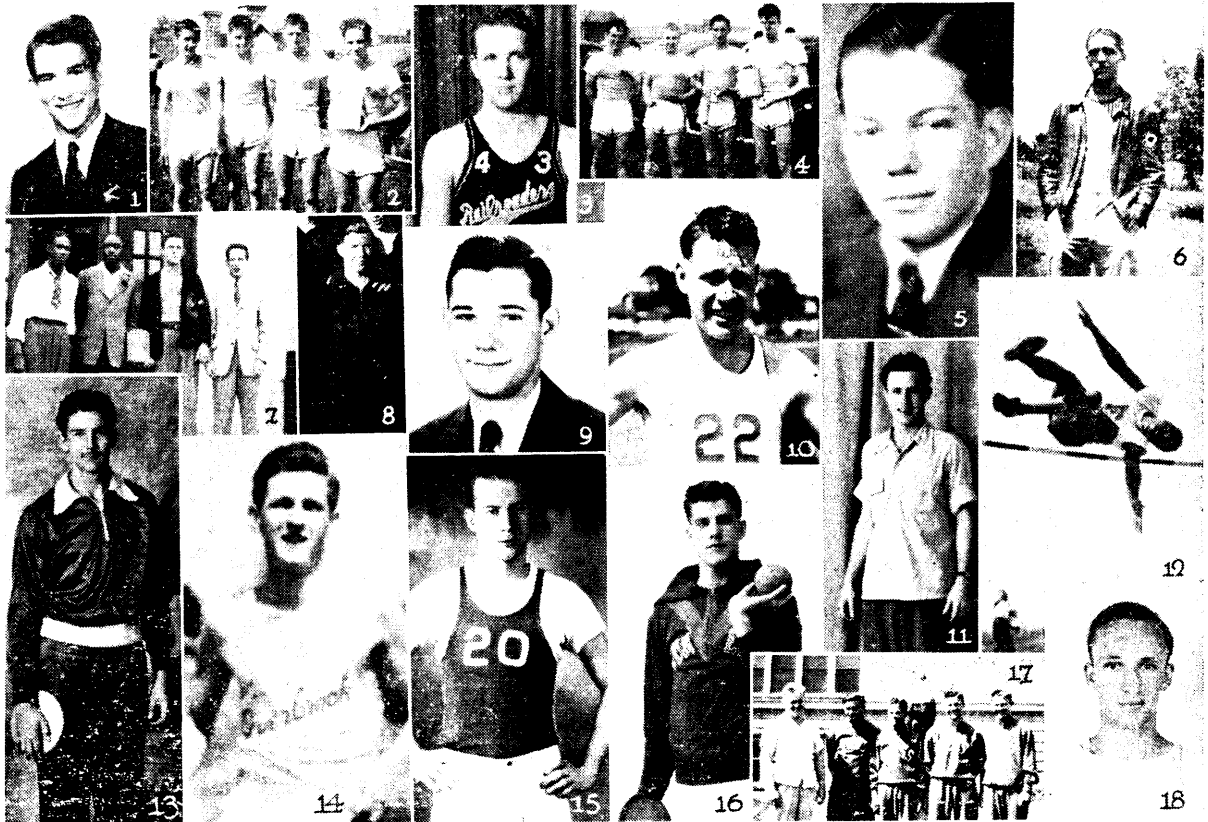

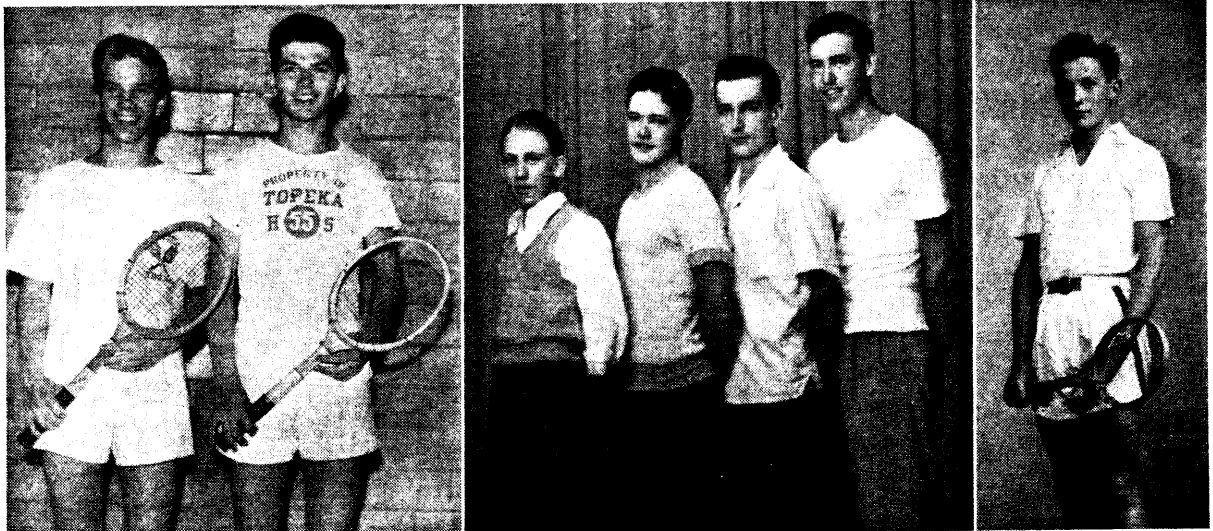
