

HUTCHINSON, ASHLAND WIN STATE TRACK TITLES

Two New Class A Records Established; Class B Division Produces Closest Team Battle in History

Two new Class A records were posted and another mark equalled, provided the highlights of the 1941 state track and field championships held at Wichita, May 16 and 17, with Hutchinson winning the Class A team title and Ashland capturing the B division.

The javelin mark set by Walton of Parsons in 1928, the oldest Class A record still standing, was eclipsed by Warren Fieandt, Wichita East, when his final toss sailed 193 ft 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ in. The former record was 184 ft. $\frac{1}{2}$ in.

Another field event mark toppled as Ed Miller, Wyandotte, threw the discus 146 ft. 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ in. to wipe out the previous best effort of McEnulty, Wichita East, who set up a mark of 145 ft. 10 in. in 1939.

Clay Center's fast stepping medley team tied the nine-year old time of Wichita East by negotiating the distance in 3 min. 27.2 sec. during Friday's preliminaries. The new co-holders of the record required an additional second to win the medley championship in Saturday's finals.

Scoring heavily in the sprint events, Coach Bill Upson's Salt Hawks returned to the top of the Class A division by amassing 30 13/14 points. Hutchinson won its two previous track championships in 1927 and 1928. Wichita East, defending champion, barely nosed out its intra-city rival, North, for second place, East scoring 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ points to North's 20. Wyandotte was fourth with 12 and Sumner fifth with 10.

Ashland sent only two entries to the state meet, but when the final tabulation of points was completed the duo had annexed the Class B title. Bill Grimes, sophomore sprint star, tacked up 14 points, while his team mate, Junior Randall, added three more for the necessary margin of victory. Blue Rapids had only one entry, Bill McRae, but he contributed 14 points to land Blue Rapids second honors. Moran was third with 13, Kiowa fourth with 11, while Burden and Elmdale tied for fifth with 10 points each.
