

Wichita East And Wamego State Cross Country Champions

Wichita East walked off with its third straight Class A title and Wamego edged Shallow Water 63 to 65 to capture the Class B crown in the 1959 State Cross Country Meet held at the Echo Hills Golf Club in Wichita on November 7.

Bob Ware of Wichita East won the Class A individual division with a time of 10:16.9. His teammate, Carl Hodges, was the runner-up, followed by third place Alex Doore of Haskell. Wamego's Jim Kientz became the master in the Class B field by edging second place Harold Hadley of Shallow Water.
