

WICHITA EAST, GARDEN CITY, PRETTY PRAIRIE WIN STATE TRACK CHAMPIONSHIPS

Two Defending Champions Annex Titles Again; Garden City Sets New Class A Relay Mark; Wiley Ties Class B High Jump Record

Two of the three state championship track teams continued to dominate their respective classes for the second straight year as Garden City claimed the Class A title and Pretty Prairie ran away with the Class B crown at Wichita on May 17 and 18. For the fourth successive year a Wichita school paced the Class AA performers, East displacing North in the championship row.

In achieving its third state AA victory in four years, East's Blue Aces rang up only one first place, but counted four seconds plus lesser points for a total of 37 3/7. Topeka was second with 30 6/7, while Sumner of Kansas City was third with 29, and Wichita North fourth with 22.

Garden City and Marysville repeated their 1945 finish in the A division. The champions garnered three firsts in their 23 point total to again outdistance their principal rivals who collected 17 tallies for second. Thirteen points earned Oberlin third place and fourth went to St. Joseph's of Hays with 12.

Close pressed a year ago to win the Class B championship, Pretty Prairie moved out in front on the third event this year and was never headed. The defending champions amassed 28 points, more than the combined score turned in by Hoxie and Holyrood who tied for second with 13 points each. Marion was fourth with 11.

One new record was posted and another was tied during the two-day meet. Garden City's fast stepping relay team composed of Gillen, Guy, Clark and Pinegar did a major overhaul of the Class A half-mile relay mark by cutting almost four seconds from the record of 1:36.4 set by Marysville in 1945. The new record is 1:32.5. Wiley of Sedgwick tied the 12-year old Class B high jump mark when he cleared the bar at 6 feet, 1 inch in winning that event. The B record was established by Stevens of Louisburg in 1934.
